

## SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CONTINENTAL TITLE HOLDER AGREEMENT

## **RELEASE**

I hereby release and hold harmless the Promoters, Anton Mulvaney, Fontasia L'Amour, Kalil Valentino and the Southern California Continental Pageantry System (SCCPS), Rich's San Diego, and their agents/employees, from any liability and/or responsibility whatsoever resulting from, associated with, or arising out of my participation in the SCC Pageant. This includes but is not limited to personal injury, or loss/damage of any personal property, regardless of where the loss or injury occurs before, during or after the pageant or any related activities associated with SCCPS.

Further, I release myself from any rights to any videotaping, photography, sound recording, still cameras or motion pictures of the SCCPS. I understand that I have the right to any of the recording (sound/video) that I may appear in.

I understand that the winner agrees to represent the SCC Pageant title with respect and professionalism during their reign as well as attend/ compete at Nationals in September in Chicago, IL. Should the winner not be able to fulfill their commitment as the SCC titleholder, the title will revert to the 1<sup>st</sup> Alternate (or appointee). Any actions the Promoters of SCC interprets as demeaning to the title or titleholder may result in forfeiture of the title with the 1<sup>st</sup> Alternate (or appointee) assuming the title.

## PRIZE PACKAGE

- Stipend at the end of the SCC Preliminary
- Crown, Sash (Miss)
- Medallion, Sash (Mr)
- Airfare to and from winner's hometown to Chicago to compete in the National Pageant in September
- Hotel in Chicago for 3 nights
- Registration fee for entry at the National Pageant
- Stipend at Registration of the National Pageant

## **TALENT SPONSORSHIP:**

SCCPS may provide additional monetary sponsorship towards a contestant's talent. This sponsorship is based at the sole discretion of the Promoters and if it's financially feasible. SCCPS asks that all representatives be able to finance their own package for the National Pageant. The most important thing is communication with the SCC Promoters. The winners may be asked to provide the necessary breakdown of any/all category expenses.

Should the winner of the SCC Preliminary forfeit or be removed from their title, or not attend the National Pageant in Chicago, they are LEGALLY obligated to return the Crown, Sash, Medallion and refund any monies given (stipend) or used to reserve hotel/airfare or talent, etc.

Winners are also expected to help identify contestants to compete in the following year's Preliminary. Additionally, the winners are encouraged to attend the following year's Preliminary to "step down" from their reigning title. The winners are responsible for getting themselves to San Diego. Hotel costs will be covered by the Promoters of SCCPS should the winners be coming from out of town.

1<sup>st</sup> Alternates, should they wish to attend the National Pageant under the SCC title, will have their Registration fee covered by SCCPS. They will be responsible for their own airfare and lodging in Chicago.
